







Overall status




What we mean by bottom-up

- 9 Directors are elected by the membership
 - The board does NOT set technical directions for projects
 - Approves new projects; oversees all projects and operations
 - No Director has any more ability to set policy than any other Director
- Members are nominated and elected by the membership
 - All ASF member votes have equal weight.
- PMC members and Committers are nominated and elected by projects
 - No one PMC member has any more say than any other PMC member as to when a release is made.




Organizational Structure

- Evaluating CDN offerings to improve world-wide access






Trademarks and Branding

- Notable this year: a number of organizations that created new software licenses based on the Apache License, Version 2.0. We worked with them to ensure that their licenses were correctly named.






Treasurer and Finance
